



## TRANSMISSION LINE CONSTRUCTION IN THE AREA

AltaLink is rebuilding the 60 kilometre (32 mile) long transmission line between Banff and Lake Louise. Between February 22 and March 31 you may see construction activities in your area.

### **HELICOPTER ACTIVITIES**

Helicopters will be used daily between February 22 and March 24 to support excavation activities between Castle Mountain and Hillsdale Meadows. Helicopters will be used intermittently each day and are used because the difficulty of the terrain makes access to some areas impossible for typical trucks.

### **DANGER TREE REMOVAL AND VEGETATION BURNING**

Trees and tree limbs that pose a risk to the line will be removed and safely burned. Between mid-February and March 31, smoke may be visible from behind the treeline of Highway 1A, and logging trucks hauling equipment and timber between sites may affect the flow of traffic. Alternating single lane closures may be needed during the loading and unloading of trucks. AltaLink in consultation with Parks Canada has determined that the burning of vegetative debris is the most cost effective option with the lowest ecological impact.

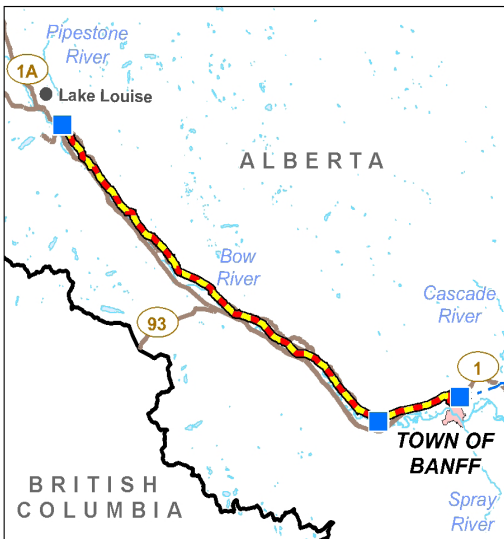
