### **Maxim Deerland Peaking Station – Project cancellation notification**

Thank you for your participation in the Maxim Deerland Peaking Station project. The project was approved by the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on December 17, 2014.

This letter is to inform you that on September 13, 2021, the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) cancelled the System Access Service Request for Maxim Power Corp.'s Deerland Peaking Power Station.
