

Project Cancellation for the Peace Butte Wind Energy Connection in the Medicine Hat Area

The Pteragen Canada Inc. (Pteragen) request for transmission system access to connect its Peace Butte Wind Power Project (Facility) in the Medicine Hat area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Peace Butte Wind Energy Connection Needs Identification Document* (NID) on May 27, 2013. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add one 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line to connect the Facility in a T-tap configuration.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval in late 2021.
