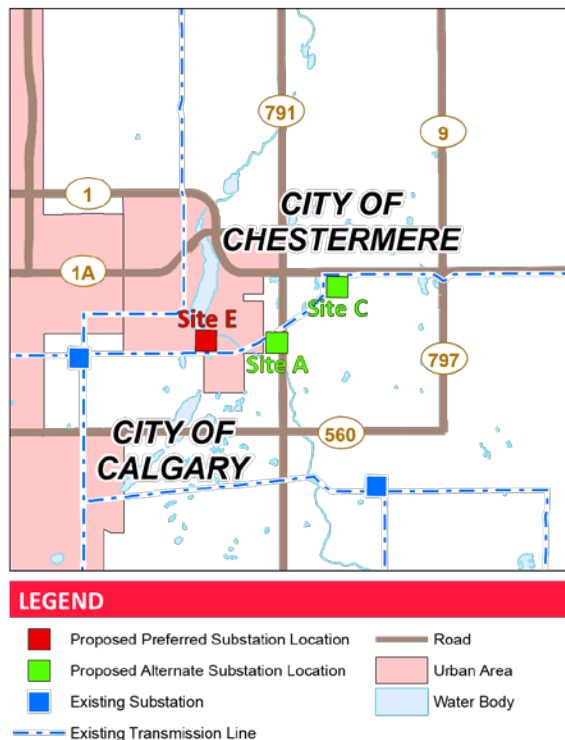

Chestermere Substation Interconnection Project update

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Chestermere Substation Interconnection project. You are receiving this letter because there have been changes to the project and we'd like to provide you with an update.

Preferred and alternate substation locations



In June 2016, we distributed a project newsletter and maps describing the preferred and two alternate locations of the proposed Chestermere Substation. In the June 2016 newsletter, site A was identified as the preferred site and sites C and E were identified as the alternate sites. After further evaluation and consultation with stakeholders, AltaLink will apply for site E as the preferred location which, as noted in the June 2016 newsletter, has been relocated slightly east on the same land parcel. Consequently, A and C are now the alternate site locations. AltaLink will proceed with these site selections in our application to the Alberta Utilities Commission.

Site E was selected as the preferred location because it has low environmental, residential and visual impacts. Site E is also located on lands that the City of Chestermere has indicated will be used for future light industrial and business development.
