Fortis Provost Reliability Upgrade Project update

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Fortis Provost Reliability Upgrade project. You are receiving this letter because there have been changes to the project and we'd like to provide you with an update.

Removal of route segment

As a result of further assessment, including stakeholder feedback, AltaLink has removed route segment A20-A50-B50 (illustrated on the included map) from further consideration as it was deemed to have a higher potential residential impact and higher estimated cost compared to other route options. If your property is located adjacent to this route segment and you are not within a minimum of 800 metres to another route segment, you will not be receiving further communications regarding this project, unless we otherwise hear from you.

Re-introduction of route segment

During the second round of consultation, AltaLink re-assessed route segment A20-B20 and determined it to be a viable option. AltaLink will be including it as an alternate route proposed for the project. As a result of removing route segment A20-A50-B50 and reintroducing route segment A20-B20, only one alternate route is being proposed for this project.

Both the preferred route and alternate route will be included for consideration in the facility application that will be filed with the Alberta Utilities Commission.

Telecommunications tower height update

In the previous project newsletter you may have received in May 2017, AltaLink stated that the height of the proposed telecommunications tower at the Killarney Lake Substation would be 20 to 30 metres tall. After further assessment, the tower is now proposed to be approximately 37 metres tall.

Schedule Update

AltaLink currently anticipates filing its facility application for the project in early 2018. If approved by the Alberta Utilities Commission, construction is forecast to start in October 2019 and be completed by May 2020.
