## **Renewable Energy Systems Canada Forty Mile Wind Power Project Connection Project Cancellation**

This letter is to inform you that on January 16, 2019, the system access service request for the Forty Mile Wind Power Project Connection has been cancelled.

### **Project background**

Renewable Energy Systems Canada Inc. (RES Canada) had requested a connection to the transmission system to connect AltaLink's existing Whitla Substation in NW 33-7-9-W4 to RES Canada's proposed Forty Mile Substation. The Forty Mile Wind Power Project was not successful in the latest Renewable Electricity Program procurement. RES Canada has informed us that they will re-submit a connection request once there is new opportunity.

As part of the project, AltaLink was proposing to build approximately 25 to 27 kilometres of 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line.
