

Cancellation for the Suncor Forty Mile Wind Power Project Whitla Connection in the Maleb area

The Forty Mile Granlea Wind GP Inc. request for transmission system access to connect the Suncor Forty Mile Wind Power Project in the Maleb area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Suncor Forty Mile Wind Power Project Whitla 251S Substation Connection Needs Identification Document* (NID) on October 31, 2019. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Modify the existing Whitla 251S substation, including adding one 240 kilovolt (kV) circuit breaker.
- Add one 240 kV transmission line to connect the Facility to the Whitla 251S substation.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The above developments are no longer needed. The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval.
