### **Suncor Forty Mile Wind Power Project Connection – Project cancellation**

Thank you for your participation in the Suncor Forty Mile Wind Power Project Connection. The project was approved by the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on October 31, 2019.

This letter is to inform you that on August 4, 2022, the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) cancelled Forty Mile Granlea GP Inc.'s request for access to the electric system. As a result, AltaLink's related project is no longer required and the AESO has directed AltaLink to apply to the AUC to cancel its permits and licenses related to the project. Information regarding the cancellation from the AESO is included with this letter.

### **Project background**

Forty Mile Granlea GP Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Suncor, requested a connection to the transmission system for their Forty Mile Wind Power project. This project would have involved constructing approximately 2.5 kilometres of new 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line, optical ground wire (OPGW) along the new transmission line, and upgrades at AltaLink's Whitla Substation, located in NW-33-7-9 W4.
