Fortis Fincastle Substation Upgrade Notice of Project Approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Fortis Fincastle Substation Upgrade project. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on February 14, 2019.

Project background

The Fincastle substation is located approximately one kilometre southeast of Fincastle Lake. The project involves adding the following new equipment to the substation:

- one new 138/25 kV transformer
- two new 138 kV circuit breakers and associated equipment
- one new combined control and switchgear building containing four new 25 kV circuit breakers

In addition, AltaLink will construct a temporary bypass line to connect the existing 607L and 610L transmission lines. The temporary bypass line will be located on land leased by AltaLink and on the edge of the adjacent road allowance, and will be removed once construction is complete.
