Intertie Restoration Project Project update

You are receiving this letter because you are near the Intertie Restoration Project, and we want to provide you with a project update.

In August 2020, we provided information to stakeholders indicating the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) was continuing to evaluate the project to determine the appropriate next steps and AltaLink paused all activities on the project at that time.

Recently you should have received an update from the AESO indicating that it will continue to evaluate all available options for the intertie restoration over the next year. As a result, AltaLink will continue to pause activities on the project until the AESO has completed this work.

We remain committed to keeping you informed and will provide you with an update when more information is available.

Project background

The Intertie Restoration Project involves electrical system upgrades to restore the intertie transmission line, which connects British Columbia and Alberta, to near its originally designed capacity. This existing transmission line is named the 1201L line. The Intertie Restoration Project includes:

- adding new equipment along the existing 1201L transmission line
- adding new equipment and expanding the fenceline at the existing Bennett Substation, located southwest of Langdon
