**749AL Urgent Transmission Line Relocation
Notice of application filing**

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 749AL Urgent Transmission Line Relocation project. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on August 16, 2018.

Next steps

The AUC will review the application and can approve, approve with conditions or deny the project. The AUC may also host a hearing regarding the project. To learn more about the AUC process and how you can become involved please visit www.auc.ab.ca.

We will notify you of the AUC's decision regarding the project. If the project is approved, salvage activities could begin as early as September 2018 and is expected to take approximately two months to complete.

Where salvage activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property. If the project is approved, you may see or hear the following during the construction process:

- noise and construction crews
- pole removal, installation and stringing activities

The application

Once your account has been created and you have successfully logged in, enter the proceeding number 23836 into the 'Go to...' search bar at the top of the page to locate the application. Alternatively, you can navigate to 'Find', click 'Proceedings' and enter "749AL" into the 'Description' search bar.

Project background

On April 29, 2018, a structure on AltaLink's 749AL transmission line failed, causing a power outage for nearby residents. Because the structures are located within a wetland, AltaLink was unable to access the structures to make the necessary repairs prior to its failure. The affected structure is located in SE-3-42-4-W4M.

To restore electrical reliability in the area, AltaLink constructed 10 new single pole structures around the wetland near Range Road 41A. On May 2, this new section of line was energized.

AltaLink is now proposing to salvage six structures, three of which are within the wetland, and has applied to the AUC for the newly constructed section of line.
