902L – 1046L Corrective Repair Notice of Project Approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 902L – 1046L Corrective Repair project. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on December 18, 2018.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- transmission structure removal, installation and stringing activities
- selective tree and vegetation clearing
- work at an existing substation

Project background

Due to extreme weather conditions, a structure on AltaLink's 902L/1046L transmission line has been damaged. AltaLink has put up warning signs alerting the public and has built a temporary "catch" structure to protect other transmission lines in the area should this structure sustain further damage. The affected structure is located in SW-15-52-4-W5M.

In order to avoid an unplanned power outage, AltaLink is proposing to replace this structure with two taller structures that will span Wabamun Lake. Additionally, approximately 200 metres

of 69 kilovolt transmission line will be relocated using similar structures to accommodate the corrective repair.

AltaLink is also proposing to temporarily reconfigure a connection of the 1046L line at the Wabamun Substation to accommodate a temporary change in electrical load as part of this project.
