

Cancellation of the Eyre 558S Substation in the Lakesend area

The FortisAlberta Inc. request for transmission system access to serve an industrial load in the Lakesend area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Eyre 558S Substation and Transmission Line Development Needs Identification Document* (NID) on March 15, 2011. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add the proposed Eyre 558S substation, including one 144/6.9 kilovolt (kV) transformer and one 144 kV circuit breaker.
- Add one 138 kV transmission line to connect the Eyre 558S substation to the existing 138 kV transmission line 7L224 in a T-tap configuration.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval in late 2021.
