KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection Project Update

You are receiving this letter because you are a stakeholder on the approved KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection project, located in the Municipal District of Provost No.52. The KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection project will provide electricity to TransCanada's Keystone Pipeline project. The KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection project was approved on May 19, 2011. As a result of the recent construction activities on the TransCanada Keystone KXL Pipeline, TransCanada has requested that AltaLink resume activities on the KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection project.

Project background

AltaLink's KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection project involves constructing approximately 17 kilometers of new 144 kilovolt (kV) transmission line, and a new 144 kV substation, called Eyre 558S which is located southeast of Houcher Lake and Highway 41. The approved substation site will be located on land owned by TransCanada Keystone Pipeline Limited Partnership, and will be constructed immediately adjacent to TransCanada's Keystone XL Pipeline. Next steps

AltaLink's contractor will be conducting environmental surveys this spring and summer on the approved transmission line route for the KXL Keystone Eyre 558S Substation Interconnection Project to gather updated information on environmental aspects. Surveys will be conducted via foot or roadside where public road access is available. If access onto private land is required for these surveys, we will contact you to request access prior to the survey date.

AltaLink will conduct a review of access trails and temporary workspace for the approved route. This may include roadside surveys. We may contact landowners if surveys on private lands are required.
