BHE Canada Rattlesnake G.P. Wind Power Connection Project

Thank you for your ongoing participation in AltaLink's BHE Canada Rattlesnake G.P. Wind Power Connection project. The project was approved by the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on September 9, 2020. We would like to provide you with an update and get your feedback.

Project update

BHE Canada Rattlesnake G.P. is building a new substation and transmission line as part of their Rattlesnake Ridge Wind Power Project. To connect their facility to the grid, modifications to AltaLink's existing 879L transmission line and a new telecommunications tower are required.

BHE Canada Rattlesnake G.P. is reducing the fence line of their Rattlesnake Ridge Substation, which has resulted in a shift in the location of their 879AL transmission line. As a result, the location of AltaLink's proposed structure on the existing 879L transmission line will need to move approximately 15 metres to the east along the existing alignment. The existing 879L transmission line is located in road allowance, south of SW-28-10-8-W4. The new telecommunications tower will also need to move approximately 40 metres to the southeast within the substation fence line, and is located in SW-28-10-8-W4.

Please refer to the map in this package to see the updated locations for the proposed transmission structure and telecommunications tower. AltaLink is not proposing any additional facilities as a result of these changes.

Next steps

We will use telephone or electronic methods to contact landowners, residents, and occupants affected by the proposed changes to gather input and address questions or concerns.

After the consultation process is complete we will file an amendment to our application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC). We will notify you of the AUC's decision regarding the project amendment. If approved, the construction will start in May/June 2021 and be completed by July 30, 2021.
