Boreal 193S Substation Connection Project Project Cancellation

Thank you for your participation in the Boreal 193S Substation Connection Project. You may have received information regarding this project previously in June 2014, July 2014, November 2014, June 2015 and/or April 2016. The Alberta Utilities Commission approved this project for construction on March 29, 2016.

This letter is to inform you that on May 24, 2019 the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) cancelled Cenovus Energy Inc.'s (Cenovus) request for system access service and the connection project has been cancelled. Project background

Cenovus requested a connection to the transmission system for their Narrows Lake Oil Sands Project. This would have allowed Cenovus' approved Narrows Lake Oil Sands Project to receive power from the Alberta Interconnected Electric System.

The project involved constructing approximately 13 kilometres of single circuit 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line that would have connected to AltaLink's existing 971L transmission line.
