BowArk Queenstown Power Plant Interconnection Cancellation

Thank you for your participation in the BowArk Queenstown Power Plant Interconnection Project. You may have received information regarding this project in June 2014, December 2014, March 2015, and/or August 2015. The Alberta Utilities Commission approved this project for construction on June 22, 2015.

This letter is to inform you that on July 25, 2019 the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) cancelled BowArk Energy Ltd.'s request for system access service and the Project has been cancelled. BowArk Energy Ltd. had requested a connection to the transmission system for their proposed Queenstown Power Plant Project, located approximately 10 kilometres northwest of the Village of Milo.

The proposed project involved constructing approximately 100 metres of new 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line and modifying AltaLink's existing Queenstown 504S Substation.
