Coalspur Substation Upgrade Notice of application filing and project approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Coalspur Substation Upgrade. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on May 7, 2021. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on May 14, 2021.

Next steps

We plan to begin construction in May 2021 and expect construction to take approximately three months to complete.

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- work at an existing substation
- a mobile substation

Project background

AltaLink's Coalspur Substation is located approximately seven kilometres southwest of the Hamlet of Robb in Yellowhead County.

The AUC has approved AltaLink's proposal to replace aging equipment at the Coalspur Substation with one new 138 kV circuit breaker. No fence expansion will be required for this project.

To avoid a potential outage while completing work, AltaLink will use a mobile substation located outside of the substation to the southeast. All work outside of the substation fence line will occur on existing AltaLink dispositions.

At this time, we do not anticipate that this work will cause any interruptions to service.
