## **749L Restoration Project Notice of application filing and approval**

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 749L Restoration Project. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on June 27, 2022. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project on July 5, 2022.

### **Next steps**

We plan to begin construction on September 15, 2022, and anticipate construction to be complete on October 31, 2022.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- work on existing transmission structures
- installation of new transmission structures

## Project background

The 749L Transmission Line is a single circuit 138 kilovolt (kV) line located in the Municipal District (MD) of Provost and MD of Wainwright. The project involves replacing two structures and modifying four other structures on the transmission line with hardware upgrades.

The existing structures on the line are wood monopole structures, between 16 to 22 metres (m) tall. The new structures will be similar but approximately 2.5 m taller. The taller structures will provide greater clearance space and the ability to increase the electricity capacity of the line.
