113L Transmission Line Structure Relocation Notice of application filing and approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 113L Transmission Line Structure Relocation project. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on November 1, 2024. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on November 8, 2024.

Next steps

We began construction in November 2024 and anticipate construction to be complete on March 31, 2025.

- noise and construction crews
- work near an existing substation

Project background

A structure on AltaLink's 113L Transmission Line is deteriorating and needs to be urgently replaced. The project is adjacent to AltaLink's Ghost Substation near the Ghost Dam berm.

AltaLink is proposing to:

- remove one structure
- add two new structures

The existing structure is a three-pole wooden structure and is approximately 16 metres tall. The new structures will be one wood H-frame structure and one wood monopole structure between 16 to 18 metres tall with guy wires. Additional right-of-way will not be required for the new structures.
