Pegasus Lake 659S Substation Upgrade – Notice of application filing and approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Pegasus Lake 659S Substation Upgrade. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on July 25, 2023. The AUC approved this project for construction on July 31, 2023.

Next steps

We plan to begin construction in August 2023, and anticipate construction to be complete in summer of 2024.

- noise and construction crews
- work at an existing substation

Project background

The proposed project involves equipment upgrades at the existing Pegasus Lake Substation, located in Woodlands County, approximately 18 kilometres north of the City of Whitecourt in NW-35-61-12-W5.

The proposed upgrades include:

- replacing one existing 69/25 kilovolt (kV) transformer with one new 72/26.5 transformer and associated equipment
- replacing one existing 69 kV circuit breaker and associated equipment
- minor substation equipment upgrades

All work will be completed within the existing substation fenceline – no expansion is required. Temporary workspace on leased Crown land outside of the substation fence may be required.
