Project background

ENGIE Development Canada LP (ENGIE) is building a new substation and transmission line for their Buffalo Trail North Wind project. To connect their facility to the grid, modifications to AltaLink's existing transmission line (called 983L) and a new fibre optic cable are required. AltaLink's project is located in Cypress County, in SW-5-11-4 W4, approximately 15 kilometres southeast of the City of Medicine Hat.

To accommodate the connection, AltaLink is constructing approximately 215 metres of 240 kV single-circuit transmission line from ENGIE's Substation to AltaLink's existing 983L transmission line. AltaLink will also install approximately 395 metres of new underground fibre optic telecommunications cable.
