Notice of application filing and approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in 712L Transmission Line Relocation. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on May 27, 2025. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on June 3, 2025.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

We plan to begin construction in mid-June 2025 and anticipate construction to be complete in Summer 2025.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- Noise and the presence of construction crews
- Increased traffic from workers and equipment deliveries
- Temporary road closures and traffic control measures
- Transmission line construction involving large equipment
- Wire stringing on transmission structures

Project background

To accommodate Rohit Group of Companies (Rohit's) upcoming construction project, AltaLink is proposing to relocate a portion of an existing 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line called 712L. The project is located in the City of St. Albert, south of Highway 633 by NE-1-54-26-W4 and NW-6-54-25-W4.

The relocation has been requested by Rohit to allow for the construction of a new traffic circle at Old McKenney Avenue and Range Road 260.

To accommodate the new traffic circle, AltaLink is proposing to modify its 712L transmission line by:

- relocating 400 metres of the line around the traffic circle
- replacing four structures on the line with six new structures

Please note: AltaLink is also proposing to relocate a 700 metre section of existing 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line in the area called 747L. The project is located in the City of St. Albert, south of Highway 633 along Old McKenney Avenue, Ray Gibbon Drive and Giroux Road.
