747L Transmission Line Relocation Notice of application filing and approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 747L Transmission Line Relocation. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on December 16, 2025. The AUC approved this project for construction on December 22, 2025.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

We plan to begin construction in March 2026, and anticipate construction to be complete in May 2026.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- transmission structure construction
- wire stringing on the transmission structures
- salvage of the replaced section of line and structures

AUC Approval

When the AUC approves a transmission project, it grants AltaLink Permits and licences. The permits and licences for this project can be viewed on the AUC website at: <https://www.auc.ab.ca/>.

To access the application, scroll down the main page and click on the 'Access here' option under 'Access to the eFiling System' and log in to your eFiling account. Project background

The AUC approved the proposed route variant to relocate approximately 700 metres of the existing 747L transmission line to accommodate the City of St. Albert's municipal developments. Please see the attached Detail Photo map illustrating the approved route.

The structures on the approved route will be monopole structures:

- made of wood or steel, depending on the engineering requirements
- guyed monopoles will be installed at A3 and A8a, and
- steel self-supporting monopoles at A6a and A20

The new structure heights for the route variant are between 20 and 27 metres tall.
