757L Transmission Line Relocation Project update

You are receiving this letter because you are near the 757L Transmission Line Relocation, and we want to provide you with a project update.

In May 2021, we provided information to stakeholders indicating we would file an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) in Fall 2021, but an application was not filed. AltaLink has engaged the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) to find the best possible options to rebuild this transmission line.

Based on this, we currently anticipate that we will not file our application with the AUC until 2023. If the project is approved, construction is anticipated to begin in 2025.

We remain committed to keeping you informed and will provide you with an update when more information is available.

Project background

AltaLink is proposing to relocate approximately 10 kilometres of the existing 138 kilovolt (kV) 757L transmission line. This line was built in 1962 and needs to be rebuilt to ensure a safe and reliable supply of power for years to come.

The portion of line that we're proposing to relocate runs along the eastern side of Range Road 30 from the Benalto Substation (in NE-12-38-3-W5) to Township Road 392 (approximately 3.5 kilometres north of the Hamlet of Benalto).
