## 759L transmission line modification

Dear stakeholder,

We are writing to let you know of a proposed modification to a transmission line near or on your property. We want to provide you information and hear your feedback about our proposal.

In order to ensure a safe distance between the existing 759L transmission line and the recently approved Central East Transfer-Out (CETO) transmission line, we need to modify structures near the Red Deer River for the 759L line.

### Project details

The 759L transmission line is currently designed with clusters of six-poles grouped closely together on either side of the Red Deer River. AltaLink is proposing to:

- Remove all six poles from the east cluster and replace them with two new monopole structures
- Remove all six poles from the west cluster and replace them with one new monopole structure

The structure replacements will increase the distance between 759L and the CETO transmission line, helping to ensure the safety and reliability of the transmission system in the area.

There will be no other modifications to the 759L transmission line. You can see where the modifications are planned in the included project map.

The existing structures are made of wood and between 19-21 metres tall. The new monopole structures on 759L will be:

- steel
- approximately 25-30 metres tall
- located in the existing right-of-way

### Next steps

We will contact landowners, residents, and occupants affected by the proposed changes to gather input and address questions or concerns. After the consultation process is complete, we will file an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC). We will notify you of the AUC's decision regarding the project application. If approved, the modifications for 759L will be completed during the winter of 2024/2025.
