

Central East Transfer-Out (CETO) Transmission Project

Helicopter activity near you

During the week of May 14, 2023, AltaLink is conducting aerial wildlife surveys within 1,000 metres of the approved transmission line route for the Central East Transfer-Out Transmission Project. The surveys will allow us to document raptor and colonial nesting birds in the area to minimize potential impacts during construction. The helicopter will primarily fly over treed habitats at a height of 100 metres and scheduling will be weather dependent.

When conducting aerial surveys, AltaLink is mindful to minimize disruption to residences, area users, livestock and wildlife. We follow permits and guidelines from Alberta Environment and Protected Areas, and we only use approved landing site and refueling locations.

AltaLink is starting activities in the coming months to support construction planning and preparation. We will contact you if we require access to your property. The activities may include:

- wildlife surveys
- agricultural pest, invasive species, and vegetation surveys

- land acquisition
