CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES IN YOUR AREA

Central East Transfer Out (CETO) Transmission Project

You are receiving this notice because we want to provide you with an update about planned activities in your area for the Central East Transfer Out (CETO) Transmission Project. Pre-construction and vegetation management will begin at the end of November 2023 and continue through August 2024. These activities are being completed in preparation for constructing the new CETO transmission line, which will start in Fall 2024.

Upcoming construction and vegetation management activities

The activities may include:

- geotechnical and environmental surveys
- right-of-way preparation
- brushing, clearing, and access preparation
- vegetation management
- ongoing reclamation of the lands on which we are working
- weed control

All work will take place on lands where AltaLink has:

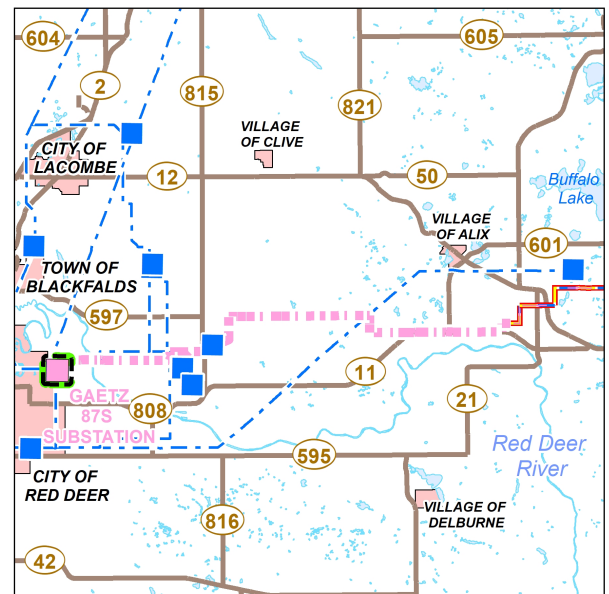
- acquired a right-of-way agreement or a right-of-entry order
- received municipal approval to work within road allowance

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:









- noise and construction crews
- ongoing tree and vegetation clearing, including logging equipment and trucks

Vegetation management work will continue as needed as the project progresses. Before removal, all vegetation will be field-verified by our crews. Vegetation will be cleared and processed by cutting, hauling, chipping, mulching, burning, and other ways.

When vegetation burnings occur, they will be highly controlled during safe conditions and follow strict safety protocols. Smoke may be visible in the area. Applicable burn permits will be in place and we will notify counties and local officials.

Vegetation management

Vegetation management ensures we can safely complete our construction activities and operate our transmission lines. It allows us to maintain a safe distance to avoid a tree making contact with a line, which can interrupt power and even cause a fire.

Traffic accommodations

There may be intermittent speed reductions and lane closures on nearby township roads and range roads to accommodate our activities. Minimal traffic accommodations may be required on Highway 11.

Traffic control measures will be in place to ensure public safety, and signs will be posted to direct people as needed.

Project background

The construction of this project is staged to align with certain generation milestones, and we are starting stage 1. ATCO Electric also has a portion of the project in its service area. You may receive information from ATCO Electric if their portion of the approved project is near you.

Stage 1 involves building a new double circuit 240 kilovolt transmission line and installing new equipment at the Gaetz Substation. AltaLink's new transmission line will be between AltaLink's existing Gaetz Substation and ATCO Electric's approved transmission line.
