**Dow Fort Saskatchewan Load
Notice of project approval**

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Dow Fort Saskatchewan Load project. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on July 15, 2026.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

We plan to begin construction in September 2026, and anticipate construction to be complete in Fall 2027.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- selective tree and vegetation clearing
- transmission structure construction
- wire stringing on the transmission structures
- installation of underground fibre optic cable

AUC approval

When the AUC approves a transmission project, it grants AltaLink Permits and Licences. The permits and licences for this project can be viewed on the AUC website at www.auc.ab.ca.

To access the application, scroll down the main page and click on the 'Access here' option under 'Access to the eFiling System' and log in to your eFiling account. If you do not have an account, select 'New personal account' or 'New organization account' and follow the steps on the screen. Project background

To connect Dow Chemical Canada's (Dow) substation Main Site BLK 80 1199S to the grid, AltaLink will be making changes to its transmission system within the City of Fort Saskatchewan and Sturgeon County.

AltaLink's project includes:

- building two new 240 kilovolt (kV) single-circuit transmission lines between Dow's project and AltaLink's existing substation called Lamoureux 71S
- modifying existing transmission lines to accommodate the construction of the two new lines
- removing the conductor and select structures from the existing D782L transmission line that is no longer in use and is not connected to the grid
- adding or modifying associated structures and equipment as needed
- installing underground fibre optic cable and optical ground wire
