Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Lac La Biche 157S Equipment Replacement project. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on March 26, 2026. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on March 31, 2026.

Next steps

Construction began in April 2026, and we anticipate construction to be complete in November 2026.

- noise and construction crews
- work at an existing substation
- increased vehicle traffic at an existing substation

The proposed project will include replacing one piece of existing equipment called a circuit switcher with a newer similar piece of equipment called a circuit breaker.

This work will be completed within the existing substation fence line; no expansion of the substation will be required.
