**Project background**

AltaLink's portion of the proposed Nilrem to Vermilion project involves:

- Building approximately 70-80 kilometres of new single circuit 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line connecting the Nilrem Substation, located southeast of the Town of Hardisty, to a new ATCO Electric line, located north of the Village of Irma.
- Modifications to the Nilrem Substation to accommodate the new transmission line.
