Scotford Solar Connection Project Notice of application filing and approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the Scotford Solar Connection Project. We submitted an application for the project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on December 15, 2025. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on December 18, 2025.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

We plan to begin construction June 2027, and anticipate construction to be complete in March 2028.

- noise and construction crews
- work at an existing substation

To support the connection of Shell's Solar Project to the grid, AltaLink is proposing to upgrade equipment at the existing Shell Scotford Substation, located in Strathcona County, approximately 10 kilometres northeast of the City of Fort Saskatchewan.

AltaLink is proposing the following upgrades to connect Shell's Solar Project:

- adding two 138 kilovolt (kV) circuit breakers
- adding or modifying associated equipment as required
