St. Albert Villeneuve Solar Connection – Project cancellation notification

Thank you for your participation in the St. Albert Villeneuve Solar Connection project. We are writing to follow up on a previous cancellation letter that contained an error related to two dates. This letter corrects that information.

In November 2025, AltaLink began consulting with stakeholders on the proposed project.

We want to inform you that on March 17, 2026, St. Albert Solar STL Inc. (St. Albert Solar) informed the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) that they no longer require a connection to the electrical grid. As a result, AltaLink's related project is no longer required.

To connect the St. Albert Villeneuve Solar project to the grid, AltaLink had proposed to:

- construct between five to seven km of new 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line (to be named 905AL) along one of four potential routes
- install a new telecommunications tower located within the Villeneuve 1040S Substation
